Dorothy Erickson is an Australian Master artist-jeweller who has been exhibiting one-of-a-kind jewellery, with over 40+ solo exhibitions in Australia and internationally since 1979.

In 2020, Dorothy Erickson was inducted into *The Design Institute of Australia, Hall of Fame*, and received *Curtin University's Lifetime Achievement Award*. The Royal Western Australian Historical Society conferred a Fellowship on Dorothy Erickson in 2019 and she won the 2017 WA Heritage Award (Individual). Her book *Inspired by Light and Land: Designers and Makers in Western Australia 1829-1969*, was shortlisted for the Premier's Book Award in 2016.

Dorothy Erickson (PhD, UWA 1992) is a significant researcher, writer, and art critic in her own right. She has four books published to date, including: A Joy Forever: The Story of Kings Park (2009); Gold and Silversmithing in Western Australia: A History (2010); Inspired by Light and Land: Designers and Makers in Western Australia 1829-1969 (2014) and A Passion for Silversmithing: PHILIP NOAKES: Gold and Silversmith (2019) to her credit.

Dr Dorothy Erickson has been exhibiting at Artsite since 2011 and is represented in numerous public and private collections both in Australia and Internationally.
